## Accessibility Guildhall

- There will be access to the Guildhall to set up Living History displays from 12:00 on Friday 19<sup>th</sup> until 17:00.
- Saturday morning access to the Guildhall for setting up from 08:30. All living history displays in main hall and displays in the Courtroom to be ready by 09:45.
- **All** modern displays including recruitment, to be set up in the courtroom.
- **NO NON PERIOD** material / display in the main hall with the living history displays
- There is a timetable – ensure that you are ready for any display 10 minutes before the start time.
- Displays on the High Street – make sure the display does **NOT** physically go beyond the Bollards.

## Cathedral

- Access to the Cathedral from 09:00 (**Not before**) – there are services before this time.
- All displays set up by 09:50
- Entrance for setting up will be from College Green.
- There are rising bollards in Edgar Gate (the entrance to College Green).
- There is vehicle access to college Green to offload Onlybut no parking.
- Cars will be limited to 6 at any one time into College Green for offloading
- No weapons are to be carried in the main body of the Cathedral.
- Ensure that you are ready before the timetabled displays.
- There are to be no non period items on the living history displays in the cloisters.
- Any food or drink to consumed from period vessels.
- The day is meant to be an enjoyable one for everyone both public and participants.

## Parking

- There is access to the rear of the guildhall, Tudor House (on Friar Street) and Cathedral Cloisters (College Green)..... to **OFF-LOAD ONLY**. There will be no parking available at any of the Venues.
- Cheap All Day parking is available at St Martins Gate multi storey and Severn Bridge – look at the location map on the site, there will be sheets available with directions on Worcester Re-enactors display in the courtroom at the Guildhall on the day, the Tudor House and the Cathedral.
- All displays at the Guildhall, Tudor House and Cathedral to be cleared away before 18:00 on Saturday 20<sup>th</sup> Feb

## **SAFETY – This applies to all sites**

- We have insurance for the event, this is for accidental injury to the public only, **not one another** – remember that safety is everyone's responsibility. This applies to **ALL** venues during the event - and any public areas in the city centre.
